One of the things Dillard-Jones Builders proves with its 2010 Southern Living Showcase Home is that 'Green' can be gorgeous. A custom floor plan by Johnston Design Group, this year's Showcase Home in Claremont community of Greenville, SC is LEED for Home project-designed and built for 'green' certification by the U.S. Green Building Council. It also will be incorporated into the Southern Living collection of national house plans as the Custom Builder Program's first collaborative design / build.

This year Dillard-Jones chose the Danze brand for many of the plumbing fixtures. Danze toilets used in this project are High Efficiency Toilets (HET) that use only 1.28 gallon of water per flush. HET toilets are water efficient yet meet the highest flush performance testing levels currently measured. Gateway Supply also has provided low-flow shower heads for the Showcase Home, which limit water usage to 2 gallons per minute, and the faucets selected use only 1.5 gallons per minute. All of that equates to a potential 20% to 30% water savings per year.

New-Home Sales Rise 6.6 Percent in September to Best Pace Since June



October 27, 2010 - Sales of newly built, single-family homes rose 6.6 percent in September to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 307,000 units, their best pace since June, according to [data released by the U.S. Commerce Department](#) on Oct. 27th. "The fact that new-home sales are finally moving in the right direction - albeit slowly - is definitely good news following an exceptionally quiet summer at builders' sales offices and model homes," NAHB Chairman Bob Jones. "The road to recovery will be a long one, however, and a key hurdle that must be surpassed is the lack of available credit for new-home construction so that builders can meet improving demand for new homes moving forward." "Beyond the higher sales figures, another positive piece of data provided by today's report was the number of newly built, unsold homes on the market, which has been steadily declining since spring of 2007 and fell again to a modest 205,000 units in September," said NAHB Chief Economist David Crowe. "This suggests that builders continue to prudently winnow down their inventories. This said, the concern is that builders' ongoing difficulty in accessing production credit will keep the razor-thin supply of new homes from being replenished as consumer demand revives, thereby hindering the positive momentum."..... Single-Family Housing Starts Rise 4.4% in September



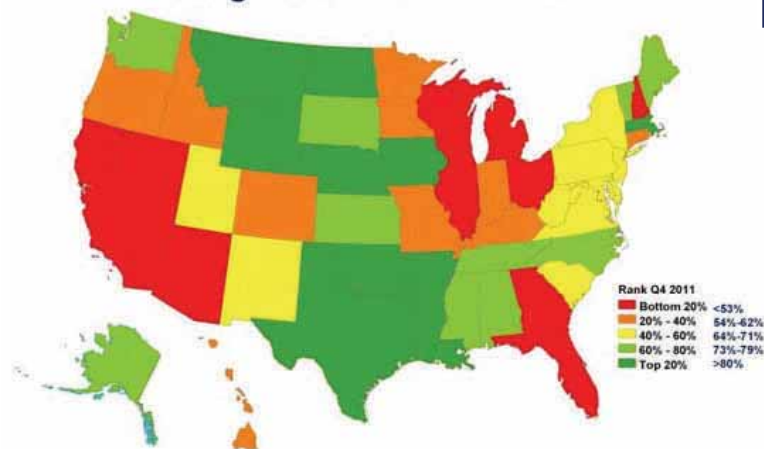
Nationwide housing starts edged up 0.3% to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 610,000 units in September, resulting entirely from a 4.4% gain in the single-family sector, [according to U.S. Commerce Department figures released](#) on October 19.

"Builders are cautiously responding to the small improvement they are seeing in the interest among potential home buyers," noted NAHB Chairman Bob Jones. "However, as consumer demand for new homes rises, a major limiting factor for a housing recovery continues to be builders' inability to access credit for new construction.".....[Click Here to Read More.](#)

In the face of far weaker post-recession economic growth than normal and discouragingly anemic job market, housing will have to wait until next year and the year after for the gains needed to dig out of its worst downturn since World War II, according to panelists participating in NAHB's Construction Forecast Webinar on Oct. 27. While economists generally have been scaling back their earlier forecasts for housing activity this year, the good news is that the job market should improve sufficiently in 2011 to begin thawing the big freeze in household formations of the past few years and to put consumers in a brighter mood, both of which are prerequisites for boosting housing demand, they said.....[Click Here to Read More.](#)

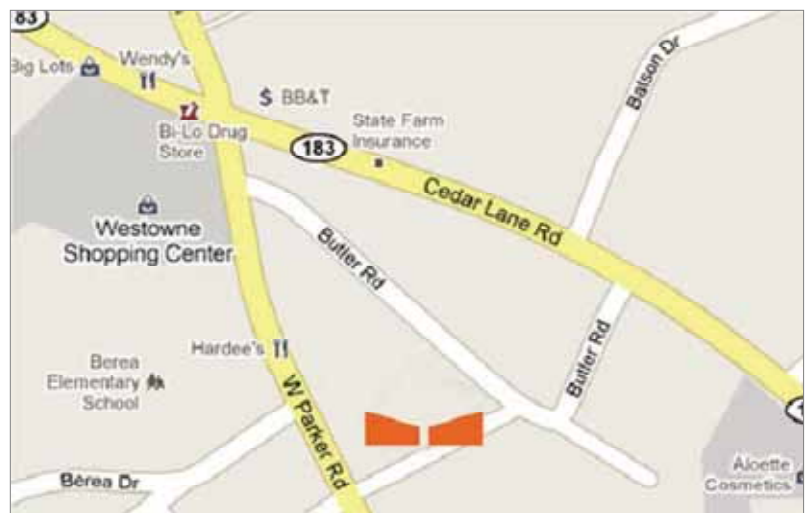

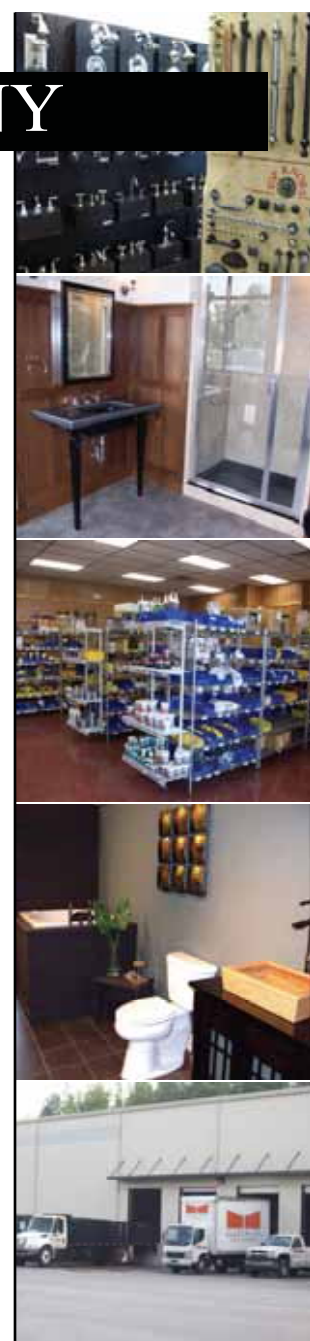
